Main Objective: Step by step approach to build common programmes between the members .

New Context:

- New structure in the landscape: The JPI on "Healthy and Productive Oceans and Seas"
- ➤ Absolute needs for Seas-era and mainly with this WP to be in line with this initiative and closely connected
- > Marifish 1 end in 2011, Marifish 2 on living resources (Fisheries Aquaculture, Seas products transformation)?
- ➤ An Era-net which soon has the experience of developing common activities at the regional level (Channel or Mediterranean) or at pan European scale (discards, ecosystem indicators, climate change impacts)
- ➤ Baltic 169 initiative is ongoing with stronger cooperation on common programmes which need to be followed as a common model of regional common programmes

Why

- Foster Synergies at regional level and pan European level to harmonize joint research priorities,
- To bridge possible gaps, avoiding duplication,
- More efficient together particularly in relation with the decrease of funding during the actual crisis.

With

 Mainly non competitive funds to increase coordination and collaboration between the major Research Performing Organizations (RPO) of the EU and associated members.

How

- Definition of common priorities to reach critical mass to address major marine and maritime research components,
- Assessment of outcomes and national and EU added values.

- Buid a common database by programmes: title, short abstract on objectives, duration, costs, manpower, infrastructures... with EurOcean End of 2010

- Analysis of the results of the enquiry, at the pan-european level by WP2 and by the regional WPs, What are common achievements on the road of common programmes?
